Dear Store Owner/Manager,

Your establishment was one of the places randomly selected in accordance with Michigan Department of Community Health guidelines to be checked for compliance with the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998, Act 58 during the month of February.

Act 58 clearly states that:

“Alcoholic liquor shall not be sold or furnished to a minor.”

Congratulations, your store was checked on February 28, 2009 at 8:00 pm and you **PASSED** the compliance check! Enclosed is a compliance certificate for your clerk/store. Please thank the clerk/server and continue to impress upon your staff the importance of checking I.D.'s and abiding by the law.

Young people obtain alcoholic beverages from a variety of sources. Reducing the source of supply through retail compliance investigations is one of the most effective strategies available to combat underage drinking. While it is clear that enforcement alone will not eliminate underage drinking, reducing the source of supply will make access to alcohol more difficult and is likely to reduce underage drinking.

Alcohol retailers are the first line of defense in stopping the sale of alcohol to young people.
